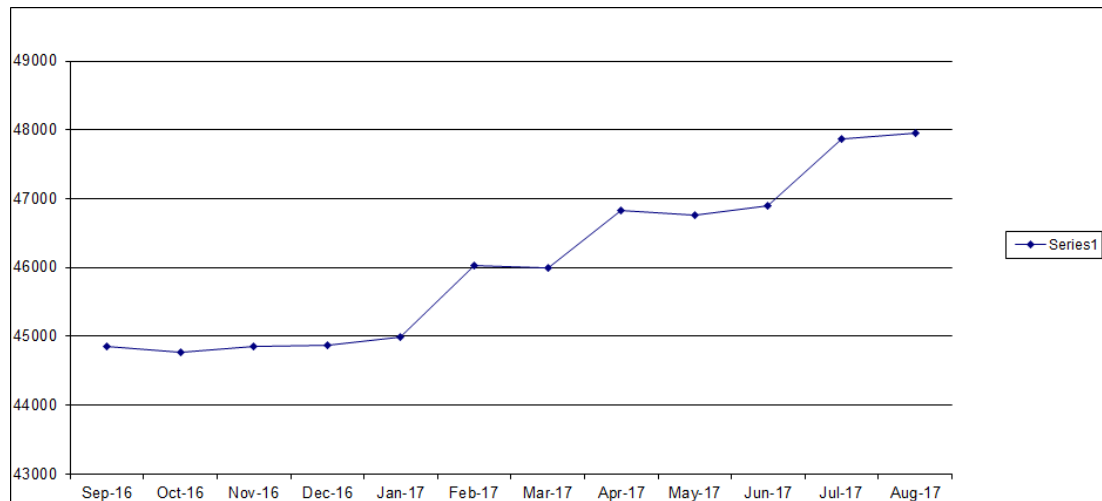
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Market Update - September 2017



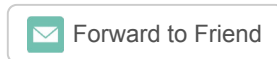
Market

The lumber market showed signs of weakness in early August before finishing the month heading upward, while OSB sold in a narrow range. The U.S. has delayed the final determination on the Countervailing Duties, suspending some of the duties being collected on lumber shipments from Canada. Despite the delay of the CVD, the market is strong due to demand, fires in British Columbia, trucking issues, and the unknown effects from Hurricane Harvey.
